 The Lao People's Democratic Republic has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Southeast Asia Regional Economic Corridor and Connectivity Project (SEARECC), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Supply of 4 Special Ambulance Vehicles for Department of Transport (DOT – MPWT).

2. The SEARECC Project, Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for supply of the following Goods:

Time of delivery – up to 5 months. The Supplier shall be required to provide Related Services for the supplied Goods, such as testing, calibrating the equipment and provide training to DoT staff for both the vehicle and the equipment supplied. The Supplier is also required to provide After-sales Service / Local Support through an authorized local distributor / retailer in Lao PDR to ensure the future support and maintenance of the equipment.

- Bidding will be conducted through the national competitive procurement using the Request for Bids (RFB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016, revised November 2017 edition ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
- 4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Project Management Unit (PMU) and inspect the bidding documents during office hours 09:00 to 17:00 hours at the address given below.
- 5. A complete set of bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below, in PDF and Word format and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of \$ 100 (One hundred US Dollars). The method of payment will be in cash. If there are any discrepancies in text, the text in the PDF format will prevail. The document will be picked up from the address below or sent via e-mail.

- 6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 14:00 o'clock of 28 February 2023. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 14:15 o'clock of 28 February 2023.
- 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration as per form provided in the bidding document.
- 8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
